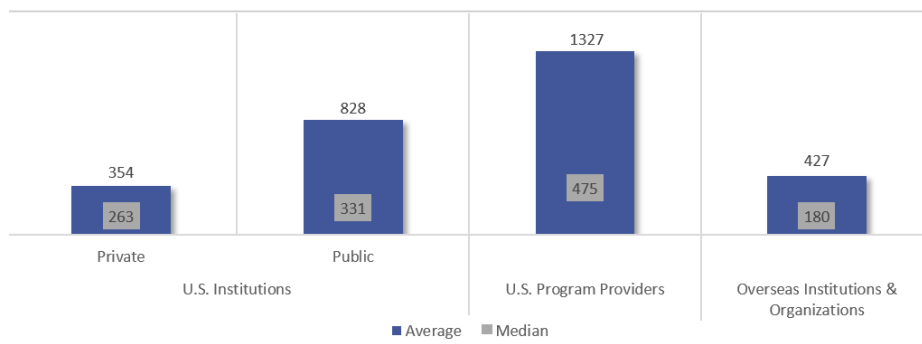

Overview

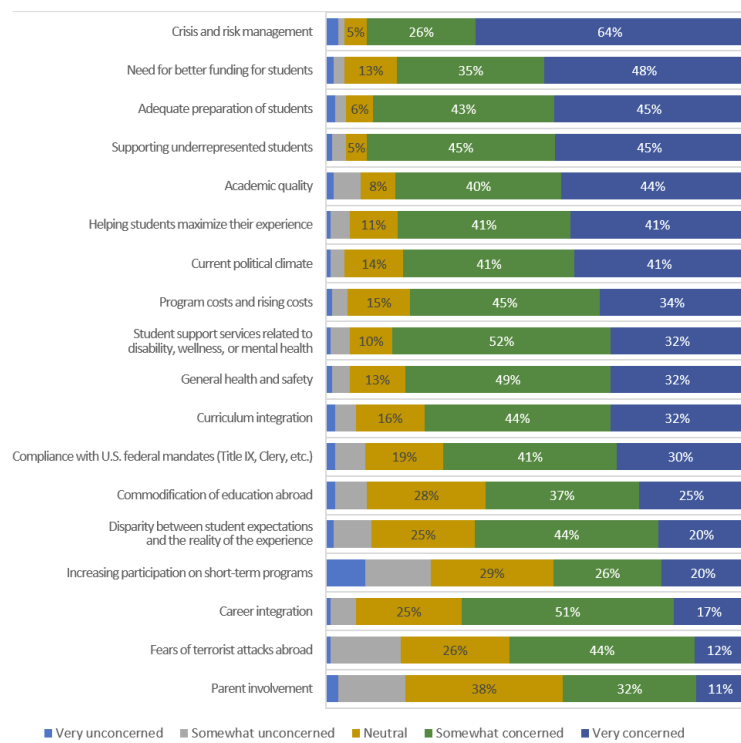
The 2017 State of the Field (SOF) Survey was developed by The Forum on Education Abroad's Data Committee and Forum staff. The 2017 SOF builds on the knowledge base of the previous six surveys in 2006, 2008, 2009, 2011, 2013, and 2015. The SOF Survey highlights the current trends of education abroad in the United States and overseas by providers and institutions, and offers evidence-based information for the planning and development of future study abroad programs. A total of 264 providers/institutions completed the survey out of 768 member representatives (34% response rate). Roy Y. Chan contributed to the data analysis and publication of the 2017 SOF Survey report.

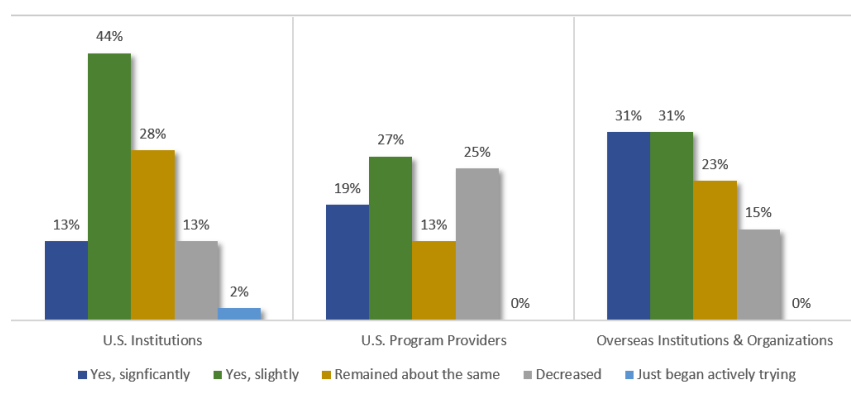
NUMBER OF STUDENTS ABROAD FROM U.S. INSTITUTIONS, 2016-2017



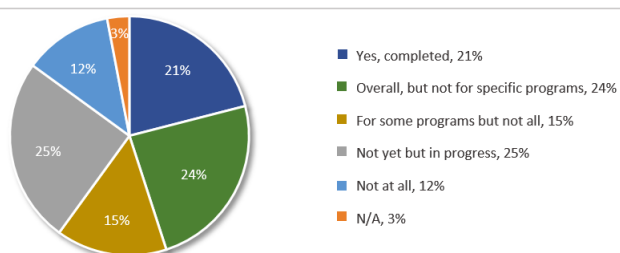
TOP CONCERNS IN EDUCATION ABROAD, 2016-2017



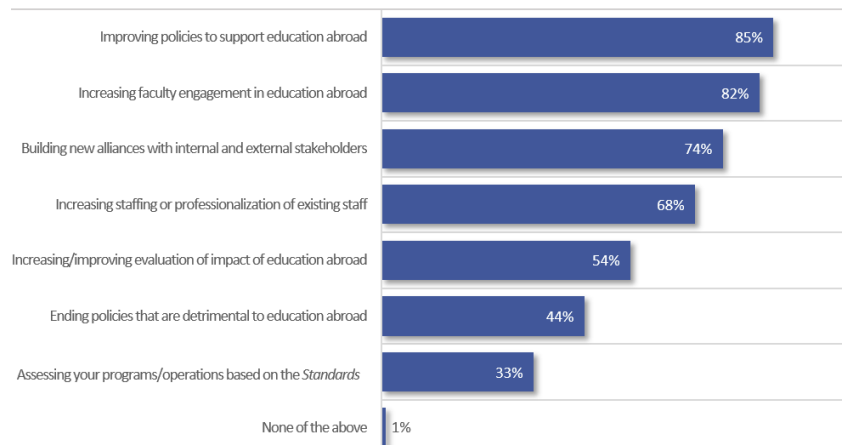
DID STUDY ABROAD PARTICIPATION INCREASED IN THE LAST YEAR?



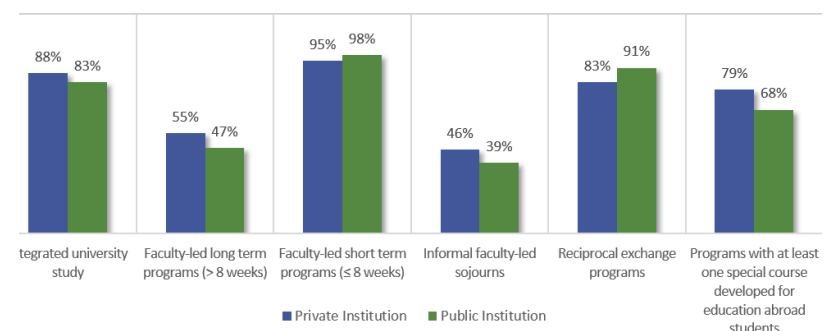

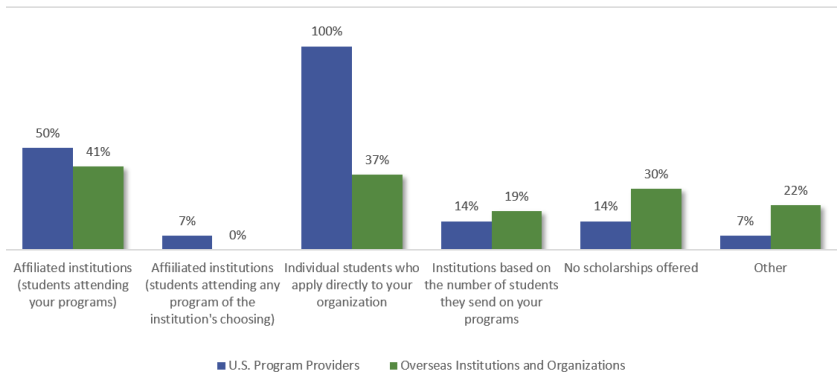
HAVE ADVOCATED FOR THE FOLLOWING WITHIN YOUR U.S. INSTITUTION?



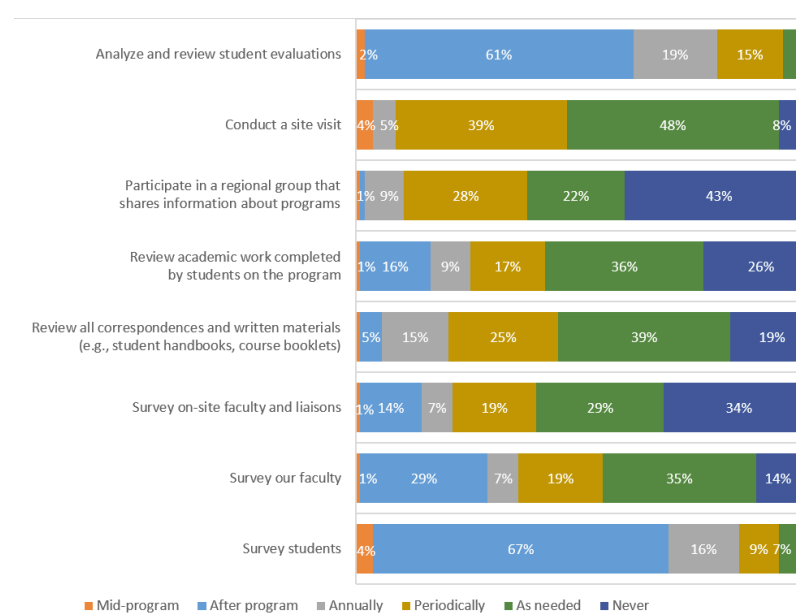
PROGRAM OFFERINGS BY U.S. INSTITUTIONAL TYPE
